Do you know which short haul drivers are running out of hours or going over air-mile limits?

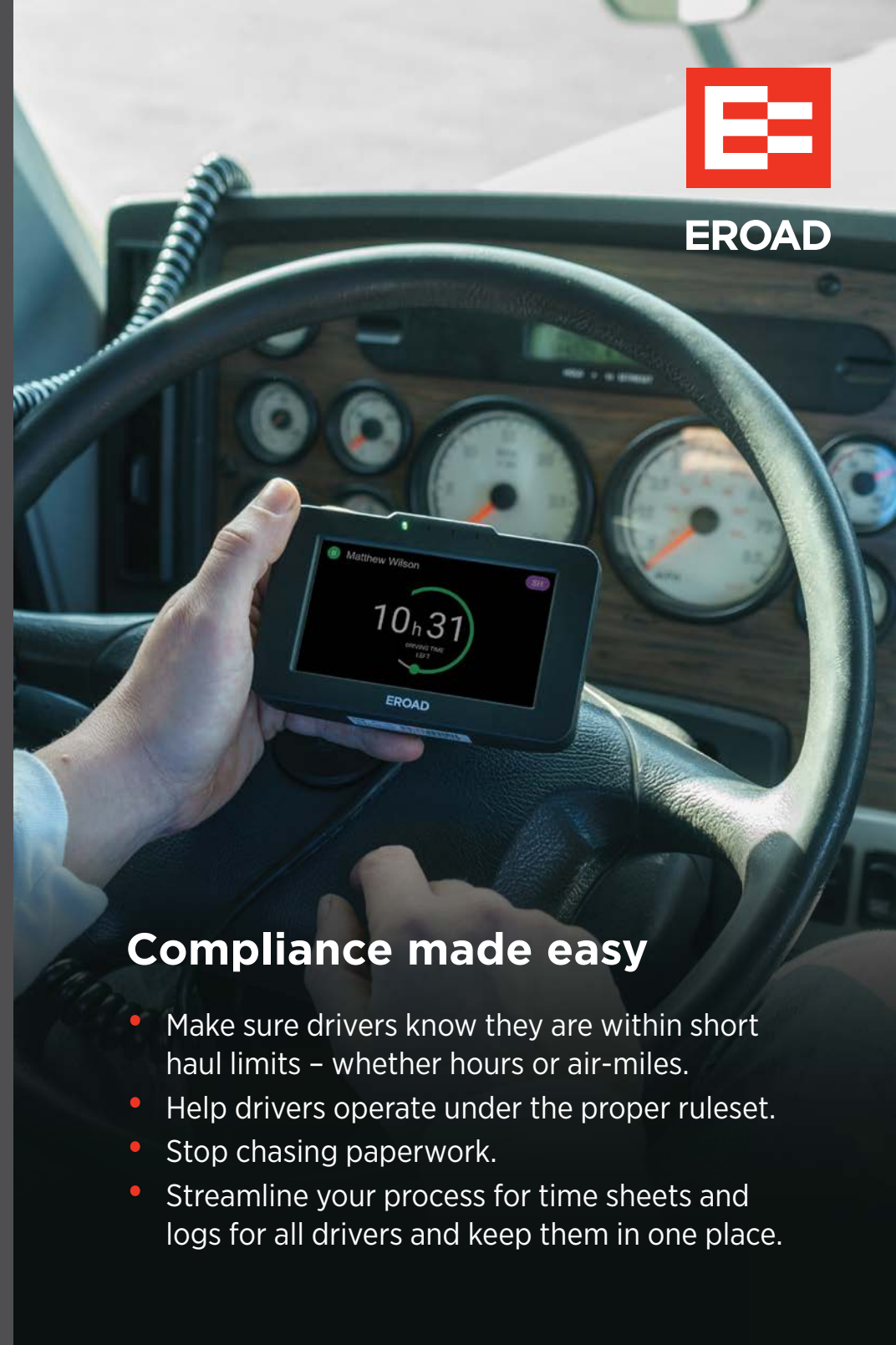

# Handling short haul criteria: Hours limit



< 13 hrs

Driver logs in and uses short haul, beginning their 14-hour countdown



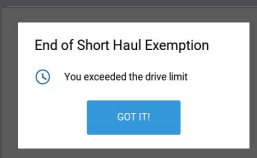
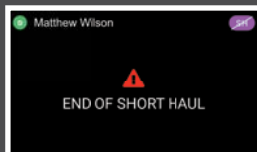
13-14 hrs

At 13 hours, driver is made aware of proximity to hours limit



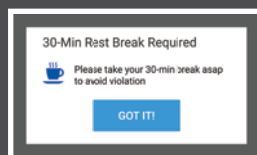
14 hrs

Once the 14-hour duty limit is reached, the driver is alerted to the end of the short haul exemption and prompted to acknowledge the change to baseline intra- or interstate ruleset



> 14 hrs

Once out of short haul, driver is prompted to take a required break if not already taken



# Handling short haul criteria: Air-miles limit



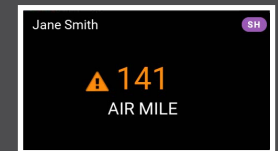
< 140 miles

EROAD Ehubo determines start location. Driver sees short haul screen during shift within the 150 mile radius



140-150 miles

Between 140 and 150 miles, driver is alerted to proximity of exceeding 150 air-mile limit



> 150 miles

Once the 150 air-mile limit is exceeded, the driver is alerted to the end of the short haul exemption and prompted to acknowledge the change to baseline intra- or interstate ruleset
