

10 Tips for Easier Roadside Inspections

STOP DREADING ROADSIDE INSPECTIONS

1



Do your pre-trip inspections

The best way to avoid delays is to fully inspect your vehicle prior to getting on the road.

2



Pay attention to CVISN alerts

You are more likely to bypass weigh station inspections with a low CSA score.

3



If stopped, find a safe location

Do not stop in the roadway or block traffic.

4



Be organized and prepared with important documents

PRO TIP: Organize all your supporting documents into a single binder for easy access

5



Be courteous and professional

A good attitude goes a long way.

6



Know which ELD you're using Is it an ELD or an AOBRD?

Each device type has different requirements and functionality.

7



Ask for the officer's safety official code when transferring logs

This ensures that your logs are transferred quickly and directly to the officer

8



Know the eRODS log transfer process for your specific ELD

Does your ELD transfer via the Telematics option or Local?

9



Have your ELD manuals and instructions at the ready

This includes user manuals and instructions for roadside inspections and malfunctions.

10



Get familiar with what enforcement officers will look for

Many inspection procedures are available online
