Waiver of IRP and IFTA Requirements Due to COVID-19

The Arkansas Department of Finance and Administration recognizes a federal state of emergency exists due to the COVID-19 outbreak; therefore, it is necessary to expedite relief efforts regarding the delivery of medical and emergency supplies as well as food and other household goods. In order to facilitate these needs, the Arkansas Department of Finance and Administration is granting a temporary waiver of requirements associated with the International Registration Plan (IRP) and International Fuel Tax Agreement (IFTA) for any commercial motor vehicle traveling into and through Arkansas that is engaged in relief efforts.

This waiver does not allow any vehicle to operate in the state without valid registration and insurance. Carriers must maintain all normal requirements that fall outside of IRP and IFTA.

This waiver is effective immediately, March 24, 2020, through 11:59 p.m. on April 30, 2020.
