### Waiver of International Registration Plan (IRP) Requirements

On August 28, 2020, the Honorable Ned Lamont, Governor of the State of Connecticut, declared a civil preparedness emergency pursuant to his authority under section 28-9 of the Connecticut General Statutes because of the severe weather conditions which occurred on August 27, 2020, and which have affected New Haven County and other areas of the state.

In response to this emergency, the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles Sibongile Magubane has authorized a temporary waiver of IRP requirements pursuant to section 14-5c of the Connecticut General Statutes for the purpose of ensuring that essential emergency supplies, equipment and services reach the areas affected by the severe weather conditions. This waiver applies only to commercial motor vehicles based outside of Connecticut that are properly registered and are entering Connecticut for the specific purpose of responding to the emergency, including utility company vehicles, vehicles providing relief services and vehicles transporting relief supplies and equipment. This waiver will remain in effect through Friday September 11, 2020, unless sooner terminated by the Commissioner.
